Minutes of the July 25th meeting were read and approved.

Floyd Valley Community Health Services director, Deb Steffen, presented an amendment to the state contract for the 2001 fiscal year. FVCHS will receive an additional \$2,800.00. Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Spies, to approve the amended contract. Motion carried.
