The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on November 8th to canvass the city elections held on November 6th for Le Mars, Brunsville, Hinton, Craig, Kingsley and Remsen. All members were present.

Results are as follows:

City of Brunsville

For the office of Mayor there were twenty-eight (28) votes cast as follows: Wayne Schlotfeldt received twenty-six (26) votes, scattering received two (2) votes. We therefore declare Wayne Schlotfeldt duly elected to the office of Mayor for the term of four (4) years.

For the office of City Council there were fifty-two (52) votes cast as follows: Josh Goodman received twenty-seven (27) votes, Jerome Schlichte received twenty-three (23) votes, scattering received two (2) votes. We therefore declare Josh Goodman and Jerome Schlichte duly elected to the office of City Council for the term of four (4) years.

City of Craig

For the office of mayor there were eighteen (18) votes cast as follows: Joe DeYoung received eleven (11) votes, scattering received seven (7) votes. We therefore declare Joe DeYoung duly elected to the office of Mayor for the term of two (2) years.

For the office of City Council there were one hundred forty-one (141) votes cast as follows: James L Grasz received fourteen (14) votes, Mike Hutton received twenty-three (23) votes, Keith Renken received twenty-eight (28) votes, Gary Schiltz received thirty (30) votes, Mona Schiltz received twenty (20) votes, Lou Dell E Schuette received twenty-two (22) votes, scattering received four (4) votes. We therefore declare Mike Hutton, Keith Renken, Gary Schiltz, Mona Schiltz and Lou Dell E Schuette duly elected to the office of City Council for the term of two (2) years.

City of Hinton

For the office of Mayor there were one hundred fifty-four (154) votes cast as follows: Richard Beaulieu received one hundred two (102) votes, Bob McQuillen received forty-seven (47) votes, scattering received four (4) votes. We therefore declare Richard Beaulieu duly elected to the office of Mayor for the term of two (2) years.

For the office of City Council there were two hundred thirty-three (233) votes cast as follows: Jeffrey R Johnson received one hundred eighteen (118) votes, Rebecca J Steen received ninety-six (96) votes, scattering received nineteen (19) votes. We therefore declare Jeffrey R Johnson & Rebecca J Steen duly elected to the office of City Council for the term of four (4) years.

City of Kingsley

For the office of Mayor there were three hundred five (305) votes cast as follows: Dean Bohle received two hundred ninety (290) votes, scattering received seven (7) votes. We therefore declare Dean Bohle duly elected to the office of Mayor for the term of two (2) years.

For the office of City Council there were nine hundred fifty-six (956) votes cast as follows: Helen Hagan received two hundred twenty-three (223) votes, Ronald Mathers received two hundred two (202) votes, Paul Niebuhr received one hundred twenty-four (124) votes, Lu Anne Ruba received one hundred seventy-four (174) votes, Tim Worrell received two hundred thirty-two (232) votes, scattering received one (1) vote. We therefore declare Helen Hagan, Ronald Mathers and Tim Worrell duly elected to the office of City Council for the term of four (4) years.

City of Le Mars

For the office of Mayor there were two hundred ten (210) votes cast as follows: Virgil Van Beek received two hundred ten (210) votes. We therefore declare Virgil Van Beek duly elected to the office of Mayor for the term of two (2) years.

For the office of City Council-Ward 1 there were seventy-four (74) votes cast as follows: Chuck Soderberg received seventy-four (74) votes. We therefore declare Chuck Soderberg duly elected to the office of City Council-Ward 1 for the term of four (4) years.

For the office of City Council-Ward 3 there were thirty-nine (39) votes cast as follows: Ken Nelson received thirty-nine (39) votes. We therefore declare Ken Nelson duly elected to the office of City Council-Ward 3 for the term of four (4) years.

For the office of City Council-At Large there were one hundred ninety (190) votes cast as follows: Rex E Knapp received one hundred eighty-seven (187) votes, scattering received three (3) votes. We therefore declare Rex E Knapp duly elected to the office of City Council-At Large for the term of four (4) years.

For the office of Park Board Commissioner there were six hundred eighteen (618) votes cast as follows: Paul D Grant received one hundred seventy-seven (177) votes, Roberta S Kass received one hundred eighty-five (185) votes, Lon Penning received one hundred eighty (180) votes, scattering received two (2) votes. We therefore declare Paul D Grant, Roberta S Kass and Lon Penning duly elected to the office of Park Board Commission for the term of four (4) years.

For the office of Park Board Commissioner, 2 year unexpired term, there were one hundred eighty (180) votes cast as follows: Reed Plathe received one hundred eighty (180) votes. We therefore declare Reed Plathe duly elected to the office of Park Board Commissioner, 2 year unexpired term, for the term of two (2) years.

For the office of Hospital Trustee there were three hundred eighty-two (382) votes cast as follows: Margie Moir received one hundred eighty-seven (187) votes, Steven H Musson received one hundred ninety-five (195) votes. We therefore declare Margie Moir and Steven H Musson duly elected to the office of Hospital Trustee for the term of four (4) years.

City of Remsen

For the office of City Council there were one hundred eighty-two (182) votes cast as follows: Craig A Bartolozzi received sixty-four (64) votes, Dean Douvia received sixty-three (63) votes, Dale Schroeder received fifty-five (55) votes. We therefore declare Craig A Bartolozzi, Dean Douvia and Dale Schroeder duly elected to the office of City Council for the term of four (4) years.
