The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on October 10, 2001 with all members present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the October 3rd meeting were read and approved.

Sharon Nieman met with the Board to ask about an architect for the waiver home to be built on the R.E. Porter site.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Spies, to change the date of the public hearing on issuance of loan anticipation notes for construction of a jail to October 31st at 1:00 P.M. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Spies, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Bruce Kellen in Section 26 of America Township on 4.85 acres. Motion carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Robert Becker in Section 26 of Elgin Township on 3.96 acres. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Dennis Anstine in Section 12 of Elkhorn Township on 3.28 acres. Motion carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Kestner, to approve the school election expenses for the September 11th election and authorize the Auditor to charge each school for their portion of the expenses. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann, to tentatively approve the Kingsley TIF presented by Gene Collins. Motion carried.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve an application for construction on county road right of way for Southern Sioux Rural Water in Section 31 and Section 32 of Washington Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner, to approve an application for construction on county road right of way for Western Iowa Telephone Association in Sections 20, 21, 28, 29, 32, and 33 of Lincoln Township. Motion carried.

Hearing on reprecincting was opened at 1:12 P.M. Eleven persons were present. A question concerning Union Township going to Kingsley was asked. It was explained that precincts cannot cross legislative lines. Hearing was closed at 1:20 P.M.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Kestner, to adopt the precinct plan as revised. Ayes----Spies, Sitzmann, Kestner, Vander Hamm and Philips. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Vander Hamm, to adopt Ordinance #101001 representing supervisor districts and waive the second and third readings thereof. Ayes----Spies, Sitzmann, Kestner, Vander Hamm and Philips. Motion carried.
