The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on September 12, 2001. Present were Vice Chair Vander Hamm, members Spies, Kestner, and Sitzmann. Absent was Philips.

Minutes of the September 5th meeting were read and approved.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve entering into an agreement for inter-county law enforcement.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Spies, to approve the costs for the LOST election held August 14, 2001 and authorize the Auditor to bill each entity as follows: Akron--\$380.90; Brunsville--\$29.65; Craig--\$22.61; Le Mars--\$2,083.90; Remsen--\$410.55; Rural--\$2,097.47. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner, to approve a contract with EMS training funds for \$9,596.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Spies, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Ronald Jones in Section 13 of Marion Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Gary Gearke in Section 11 of America Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve an on-going contract with Moore & Associates as architect for the jail facility. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann, to raise the hourly rate of election workers to \$6.50 an hour effective immediately. Motion carried.
