The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on December 11, 2002 with all members present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the November 27<sup>th</sup> and December 4<sup>th</sup> meetings were read and approved.

Bids were opened for the driver licensing cabinetry. \$5,100.00 & \$3,188.00

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann to accept the low bid of \$3,188.00 from Tom Kurth to build the drivers licensing cabinetry. Philips Nay. Motion carried.

Fred Hutchins asked the board to increase the cost of temporary heating for the jail. Rental of the equipment for seasonal heating will actually be closer to \$6,500. \$343.00 for locks on two doors in the laundry area. One wall in the basement needs to have deeper studs at \$165.00, \$7,204 for exterior coating update, \$983 for decrease in public locker space, \$4,768.00 to raise a ceiling higher (not recommended), \$426.71 deduct for the Sheriff's Office carpet with a later increase for carpet upgrade.

The 5 county libraries presented their request for the 2003-2004 budget year of \$52,000.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner to try to procure a cannon for display on the Courthouse lawn. Motion carried.
