The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on February 26, 2002 to canvass the Hinton Special Election held on February 19, 2002. Present were members Kestner, Sitzmann and Spies. Absent were Vander Hamm and Philips.

Upon the public measure *“Shall the Board of Directors of the Hinton Community School District in the County of Plymouth, State of Iowa, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years to levy and impose a voter-approved physical plant and equipment tax of not exceeding one dollar and thirty-four cents (\$1.34) per One Thousand dollars (\$1000) of assessed valuation of the taxable property within the school district?”*

There were five hundred twenty eight (528) votes cast as follows:

FOR the question there were two hundred nineteen (219) votes cast.

AGAINST the question there were two hundred ninety-nine (299) votes cast.

There were ten (10) blank votes.

We therefore declare the public measure “see above” to be not adopted.
