The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on March 13, 2002. Present were Chairman Vander Hamm, members Philips, Kestner and Sitzmann. Absent was Spies.

Minutes of the March 6th meeting were read and approved.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Philips, to approve Ordinance #031302 pertaining to local option sales tax and to waive the second and third readings. Ayes---Kestner, Sitzmann, Philips and Vander Hamm. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner, to authorize the Chairman to sign a letter of intent with Ruan Securities for issuance of \$5,400,000.00 in bonds.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Philips, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for John Ahlers on 6.88 acres in section 3 of Stanton township. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Kenneth Krieg on 3.4 acres in section 14 of Elkhorn township. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to commercial for Mel Crawford on 38.97 acres in section 31 of Hungerford township. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Matthew Hall in section 34 of Hungerford township. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Kestner, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Kevin Liudahl on 10.2 acres in section 33 of Perry township. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve an agreement with the IDOT on bridge projects #BROS-CO-#BROS-CO75(82)--8J-75 and BROS-CO75(83)--8J-75. Motion carried.

A hearing was opened at 11:30 A.M. on the sale of property in section 4 of Washington township. One person was present for the hearing representing the cemetery. Hearing was closed at 11:35 A.M.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Philips, to adopt Resolution #031402 to vacate a portion of roadway in section 4 of Washington township. Ayes---Philips, Sitzmann, Kestner and Vander Hamm. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann, to honor the request for \$3000.00 to cover promotional materials for Loess Hills Alliance. Motion carried.
