Motion by Spies, seconded by Philips, to approve a liquor permit and cigarette permit for Mike's Saloon. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Philips, to accept the low bid of \$285,500.00 on the Plymouth County waiver home from Timmins Construction on condition of a bid bond and 5% cashiers check within 10 days. Motion carried.
