Motion by Philips, seconded by Kestner, to authorize the Chairman to sign letters concerning 2 manure management plans for Nothem Brothers Finishing Barn in section 11 of Henry township and Jeff Pottebaum in section 9 of Remsen township. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve two applications for construction on county road right of way for Southern Sioux County Rural Water System in sections 3 and 10 of Elgin township and section 2 of Johnson township. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Philips, to approve a contract on project #LB-281502--73-75 with Graves Construction Inc. for \$155,665.77. Motion carried.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Kestner, to approve a contract on project #LC-063085--73-75 with Herbst Construction Inc. for \$31,476.15. Motion carried.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Philips, to approve an agreement with the Chicago Central & Pacific Railroad for a crossing on county road K-64. Motion carried.
