The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on September 13, 2002 to canvass the results of the School Board election held on September 3, 2002. Present were Chairman Vander Hamm, members Sitzmann, Kestner and Philips. Absent was Spies.

The following results were found:

REMSEN UNION

For the office of Director District 1 there were seventy-five (75) votes cast as follows: Jeff Stoos received thirty-three (33) votes; Jill E Utesch received forty-two (42) votes. We therefore declare Jill E Utesch duly elected to the office of Director District 1 for the term of 1 year.

For the office of Director District 2 there were thirty-seven (37) votes cast as follows: Keith Ahlers received thirty-seven (37) votes. We therefore declare Keith Ahlers duly elected to the office of Director District 2 for the term of 3 years.

For the Director District 4 there were forty (40) votes cast as follows: Tony Paskert received thirty-seven (37) votes; scattering received three (3) votes. We therefore declare Tony Paskert duly elected to the office of Director District 4 for the term of 2 years.

Upon the public measure "*Shall the Board of Directors of Western Iowa Tech Community College in the Counties of Buena Vista, Carroll, Cherokee, Crawford, Harrison, Ida, Monona, Plymouth, Sac, Shelby, Sioux and Woodbury, State of Iowa cause to be levied a tax not to exceed six (6) cents per thousand dollars of assessed value in any one year for a period of ten consecutive fiscal years beginning with the tax levy to be made for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, for either of the following purposes: program sharing between community colleges or for the purchase of instructional equipment; or for such other purposes as authorized by law, as provided in Chapter 260C, Section 28 of the Code of Iowa?*"

There were one hundred sixty-nine (169) votes cast as follows:

FOR the question there were seventy-four (74) votes cast.

AGAINST the question there were ninety-five (95) votes cast

We therefore declare the public measure "see above" to be not adopted.

LE MARS COMMUNITY SCHOOL

For the office of Director District 3 there were ninety-seven (97) votes cast as follows: Marjorie Franke received ninety-six (96) votes; scattering received one (1) vote. We therefore declare Marjorie Franke duly elected to the office of Director District 3 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 5 there were ninety-five (95) votes cast as follows: Dan Smith received ninety-five (95) votes. We therefore declare Dan Smith duly elected to the office of Director District 5 for the term of 3 years.

Upon the public measure "*Shall the Board of Directors of Western Iowa Tech Community College etc., see above.*"

There were one hundred one (101) votes cast as follows:

FOR the questions there were fifty-five (55) votes cast.

AGAINST the question there were forty-six (46) votes cast.

We therefore declare the public measure "see above" to be adopted.

KINGSLEY-PIERSON

For the office of Director District 2 there were one hundred nine (109) votes cast as follows: Bud Herbold received one hundred nine (109) votes. We therefore declare Bud Herbold duly elected to the office of Director District 2 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 3 there were one hundred four (104) votes cast as follows: Charlie E Hardie received one hundred four (104) votes. We therefore declare Charles E Hardie duly elected to the office of Director District 3 for the term of 2 years.

For the office of Director District 4 there were one hundred one (101) votes cast as follows: Cindy Powell Inman received one hundred one (101) votes. We therefore declare Cindy Powell Inman duly elected to the office of Director District 4 for the term of 3 years.

Upon the public measure *“Shall the Board of Directors of Western Iowa Tech Community College etc., see above.”*

There were one hundred one (101) votes cast as follows:

FOR the question there were seventy (70) votes cast.

AGAINST the question there were thirty-one (31) votes cast.

We therefore declare the public measure “see above” to be adopted.

HINTON

For the office of Director At Large there were five hundred forty-two (542) votes cast as follows: Douglas D Becker received one hundred sixteen (116) votes; Robert D Held received two hundred twenty-four (224) votes; Kenneth Hoefling received one hundred ninety-three (193) votes; scattering received nine (9) votes. We therefore declare Robert D Held and Kenneth Hoefling duly elected to the office of Director At Large for the term of 3 years.

Upon the public measure *“Shall the Board of Directors of Western Iowa Tech Community College etc., see above.”*

There were two hundred seventy-three (273) votes cast as follows:

FOR the question there were one hundred twenty-six (126) votes cast.

AGAINST the question there were one hundred forty-seven (147) votes cast.

We therefore declare the public measure “see above” to be not adopted

AKRON-WESTFIELD

For the office of Director District 5 there were three hundred thirty-three (333) votes cast as follows: Jeff Buryanek received three hundred twenty-seven (327) votes; scattering received six (6) votes. We therefore declare Jeff Buryanek duly elected to the office of Director District 5 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 6 there were three hundred forty-nine (349) votes cast as follows: Kirk Banks received three hundred forty-four (344) votes; scattering received five (5) votes. We therefore declare Kirk Banks duly elected to the office of Director District 6 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director At Large there were four hundred seventy-nine (479) votes cast as follows: Randy Hope received one hundred twelve (112) votes; Roger Oetken received three hundred sixty-seven (367) votes. We therefore declare Roger Oetken duly elected to the office of Director At Large for the term of 3 years.

Upon the public measure *“Shall the Board of Directors of Western Iowa Tech Community College etc., see above.”*

There were four hundred fifty-seven (457) votes cast as follows:

FOR the question there were one hundred eighty-one (181) votes cast.

AGAINST the question there were two hundred seventy-six (276) votes cast.

We therefore declare the public measure “see above” to be not adopted.

**WESTERN IOWA TECH COMMUNITY COLLEGE
DIRECTOR DISTRICT 7**

For the office of Western Iowa Tech Community College Director District 7 there were one hundred seventy-nine (179) votes cast as follows: Curt Grigg received one hundred sixty-nine (169) votes; scattering received ten (10) votes. We therefore declare Curt Grigg duly elected to the office of Director District 7 for the term of 3 years.

Upon the public measure "*Shall the Board of Directors of Western Iowa Tech Community College etc., see above.*"

There were one thousand one hundred one (1101) votes cast as follows:

FOR the question there were five hundred six (506) votes cast.

AGAINST the question there were five hundred ninety-five (595) votes cast.

We therefore declare the public measure "see above" to be not adopted.
