The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on September 25, 2002 with all members present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Kestner, to approve the billing of election costs to Plymouth County school districts for the September 10<sup>th</sup> school board elections as follows: Akron-Westfield for \$633.20; Hinton Community for \$366.69; Kingsley-Pierson for \$541.83; Le Mars Community for \$1,096.64; Remsen-Union Community for \$477.65. Motion carried.

Treasurer, Linda Dobson, presented financial information about issuing drivers license as a county function. Motion by Spies, seconded by Sitzmann, to enter into a 28E agreement with the IDOT for a driver's license station. Ayes---Philips, Kestner, Sitzmann, Spies and Vander Hamm. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Kestner, to approve a tax suspension for Richard Leaverton. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve an agreement with Frontier Communications to install a pedestal box in sections 18 and 19 of Fredonia Township. Motion carried.
