The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met at 5:00 p.m. in the Le Mars City Council Chambers on December 10, 2003. All members were present.

The purpose of the meeting is to hold a public hearing for a Community Development Block Grant for Brentwood Good Samaritan Center.

Present were the media (radio and newspaper), Karen Mousel, Patti Anderson, and Nick Fosness.

The hearing was opened at 5:00.

The Chairman read the public notice from the newspaper giving a review of the following:

The need for the activities was indicated by the estimation of 77 million baby boomers joining the 34 million over age 65 by the year 2020

How the proposed activities will be funded and the source of funds:

Brentwood Good Samaritan Center reserve funds & other private donations \$547,096.00

Le Mars Local Option Sales Tax Funds \$50,000.00

Community Development Block Grant \$413,064.00

The CDBG application will be submitted no later than December 19<sup>th</sup>

The requested amount of funds will be \$413,064.00

About 74% of the federal funds will benefit low- and moderate-income persons

The proposed project will be a building addition on the south side of the existing Brentwood Center

There will be no displacement of persons resulting from the building addition

Project will provide a 4840 sq. ft. building addition to house Alzheimer's Disease and other dementia-related Care Center, a Geriatric Outpatient Rehabilitation Center, and a Senior Wellness Center serving 110 more people

Nick Fosness, Brentwood Administrator, gave a summary of the project and what it entails.

Patti Anderson from Simpco gave an overview of the CDBG project and it's importance to the citizens of the community and state of Iowa.
