The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on March 25, 2003. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the March 18, 2003 meeting were read and approved.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Philips to approve the hiring of Steve Schnepf as custodian for the new jail effective May 1, 2003. Motion carried.

Motion by Greene, seconded by Philips to adopt Resolution #032503 on a road embargo. Greene – aye, Philips – aye, Spies – aye, Vander Hamm – aye, Sitzmann – aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Vander Hamm to adopt Resolution #032603 on service member support. Greene – aye, Philips – aye, Sitzmann – aye, Vander Hamm – aye, Sitzmann – aye. Motion carried.

Fred Hutchins gave the Board and update on the jail project.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Greene to enter into a 28E agreement with the city of Merrill concerning their cost of the co. jail / communication center. Motion carried.

Red Wiltgen was in to complain that he has not received December or January (pay requests 9 & 10); payments due him at this time. The County Attorney asked if Red had contacted PCS to discuss what he could do to get these 2 payments finished. The sprinkler contractor was paid \$6,498.00 in July, 2002, prior to this work being done. Red feels this is in contrast with his non-payment, although the work was completed.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Vander Hamm to approve a tax suspension for Dennis Beeck on property in Akron for the 2002 tax year. Motion carried.
