The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on September 23, 2003. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Philips, to name Melvin Brown and Bill Koopman to the Hwy 60/75 By-pass Committee along with 2 Board members, Jack Spies and Richard Philips. An alternate for any of these members will be chosen from the Board of Supervisors. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Spies, to appoint Dave Vander Hamm and Gordon Greene to work with the Auditor as consultants on the 3rd floor renovation. Motion carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Greene, to approve a contract with Joseph Shoemaker, Dorothy Ruby, and Priscilla Shoemaker for gravel at \$.60 per ton for an estimated 50 to 60,000 ton. Motion carried.

The hearing for Wireless Network Management was opened at 1:38 p.m. The land description was discussed for a 190' tower (without guy wires) in Section 24-93-45. The hearing was closed at 2:02 p.m.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Spies, to approve a 190' tower for Wireless Network Management in Section 24-93-45. Motion carried.
