The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met on July 13, 2004. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the July 6, 2004 meeting were approved.

Sheriff Mike Van Otterloo introduced a new deputy Aaron Leusink who began work on July 12, 2004.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Philips, to accept the Recorder's and Sheriff's Quarterly Reports for the quarter ending 6-30-04. Motion Carried.

Hearing on surplus property south of Group Home was opened at 10:00 a.m. One bid was received for \$6,000. A minimum bid of \$10,000 was required. The hearing was closed at 10:05 a.m.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Sitzmann, to refuse the bid for \$6,000 on surplus property south of 12th Street. Motion Carried.

Motion by Greene, seconded by Philips, to put a minimum price of \$6,000 on surplus property to be sold at auction as soon as possible by the county sheriff. Motion Carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Vander Hamm, to authorize the Chairman to sign a contract with Graves Construction Co, Inc. on project #BROS-CO75(88)—8J-75 for \$141,863.60. Motion Carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Philips, to hire Sioux Sweeping to PCC joint fill on approximately 6 miles on K18 & K49. Motion Carried.
