The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met on September 17, 2004 to canvass the school board election held on September 14<sup>th</sup>. Present were Chairman Spies, members Greene and Vander Hamm. Absent were members Philips and Sitzmann.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Greene, to approve the canvass as follows:

#### AKRON-WESTFIELD

For the office of Director District 2 (un-expired term) there were one hundred fourteen (114) votes cast as follows: Kimberly Burrack received forty-two (42) votes; Phil Parks received seventy-two (72) votes. We therefore declare Phil Parks duly elected to the office of Director District 2 for the term of 2 years.

For the office of Director District 3 there were one hundred one (101) votes cast as follows: Gordy Johnson received one hundred one votes. We therefore declare Gordy Johnson duly elected to the office of Director District 3 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 4 there were one hundred five (105) votes cast as follows: James Black received one hundred five votes. We therefore declare James Black duly elected to the office of Director District 4 for the term of 3 years.

#### HINTON COMMUNITY

For the office of Director District At-Large there were thirty-one (31) votes cast as follows: Lynette Blanchard received thirty (30) votes; scattering received one (1). We therefore declare Lynette Blanchard duly elected to the office of Director District At-Large for the term of 3 years.

#### KINGLSEY-PIERSON

For the office of Director District 3 there were forty-four (44) votes cast as follows: Scott Bohle received forty-four (44) votes. We therefore declare Scott Bohle duly elected to the office of Director District 3 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 5 there were forty-one (41) votes cast as follows: Tim Sudbeck received forty-one (41) votes. We therefore declare Tim Sudbeck duly elected to the office of Director District 5 for the term of 3 years.

#### LEMARS COMMUNITY

For the office of Director District 2 there were ninety-two (92) votes cast as follows: Cris A. Collins received ninety-two (92) votes. We therefore declare Cris A. Collins duly elected to the office of Director District 2 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District At-Large there were ninety-two (92) votes cast as follows: Patrick N. Murphy received ninety-two (92) votes; Mark Stelzer received ninety-one (91) votes; scattering received one (1) vote. We therefore declare Patrick N. Murphy and Mark Stelzer duly elected to the office of Director District At-Large for the term of 3 years.

#### REMSSEN-UNION

For the office of Director District 3 there were seventy-eight (78) votes as cast as follows; Mark Kunkel received twenty (20) votes; Rich Van Dam received fifty-eight (58) votes. We therefore declare Rich Van Dam duly elected to the office of Director District 3 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 4 there were fifty- nine (59) votes cast as follows: Shirley Schroeder received forty- seven (47) votes; scattering received twelve (12) votes. We therefore declare Shirley Schroeder duly elected to the office of Director District 4 for the term of 3 years.

WESTERN IOWA TECH COMMUNITY COLLEGE

For the office of Western Iowa Tech Director, District 1 there were two hundred seventy (270) votes cast as follows: Norm Lang received two hundred sixty-eight (268) votes; scattering received two (2).
