The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on February 22, 2005 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the February 15, 2005 meeting were approved.

Schneider attended the Plymouth County landfill board meeting. Mark Kunkel has been hired as the landfill manager.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Henrich, to pay the urban renewal TIF billings from the General Basic Fund and the Economic Development department. Motion Carried.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve the ROW adjustment to equalize all payments to property owners on Keystone Avenue totaling \$6,023.15. Motion Carried.

Public hearing opened at 1:00 p.m. for the purchase option of county owned property in Section 10-92-45. Evelyn Weber was present to express concern regarding drainage and flooding of this land and her land adjacent to this property. The land was appraised for \$115,000 by Barry Lancaster. The public hearing was closed at 1:16 p.m.

Motion was made by Greene to set the selling price for the county owned property of 2.97 acres in Section 10-92-45 as \$85,000. Motion died for lack of second.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Sitzmann, to set the selling price for the county owned property of 2.97 acres in Section 10-92-45 as \$69,000. Schneider-aye; Spies-aye; Henrich-aye; Sitzmann-aye; Greene-nay Motion Carried.
