The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on August 15, 2006 at 9:30 a.m. Present were Chairman Sitzmann, members Henrich, Greene and Schneider. Absent was Anderson. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

The agenda for the August 15, 2006 meeting was approved.

Minutes of the August 8, 2006 meeting were approved.

Motion by Greene, seconded by Henrich, to approve a minor subdivision for Ideal Addition (one lot) in Sec 16 Plymouth Township. Motion Carried.

Motion by Henrich, seconded by Greene, to approve Resolution #081506, to accept, approve and re-accept the Steichen First Addition (a minor subdivision) in Sec 26 Fredonia Twp, with a letter from Zoning stating the house on the property is in code violation with existing penalties.
Greene-aye; Henrich-aye; Schneider-aye; Sitzmann-aye Motion Carried.

Motion by Schneider, seconded by Henrich, to approve Birk Addition, a minor subdivision, in Sec 21 Perry Township on 7.17 acres. Motion Carried.

Motion by Henrich, seconded by Schneider, to approve a permanent easement from the Chicago, Central & Pacific Railroad Company to Plymouth County in Sec 30 America Twp at no cost to the county. Motion Carried.

A letter sent by Craig Anderson stating his concerns on the L.B.I.C. \$600,000 loan was read aloud in his absence.

Motion by Schneider, seconded by Greene, to direct the County Attorney to draw up a resolution indicating the \$600,000 to be given to the LBIC as an interfund loan transaction from county reserves, and draw up a joint mortgage agreement with the NW REC. Motion Carried.
