The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on September 12, 2006 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

The agenda for the September 12, 2006 meeting was approved.

Minutes of the September 5, 2006 meeting were approved.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Greene, to approve the local incentive package as presented for Plymouth Energy, L.L.C. with the following restrictions: Requested road improvements are included in plant construction costs and paid by Plymouth Energy, L.L.C.; Plymouth Energy, L.L.C. and the City of Merrill agree not to annex for the duration of the TIF; Plymouth Energy, L.L.C. does agree not to request Abatement under Section 427B of the Iowa Code; and Proposal is approved by bond council.
