The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom to canvass the school election that was held on September 11, 2007. Present were Vice Chairman Schneider, members Kass, Anderson & Greene. Absent was Henrich.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve the canvass of the School Board Election as presented:

AKRON –WESTFIELD

For the office of Director District 3 there were fifty-seven (57) votes cast as follows: Joshua Martinsen received forty-four (44) votes; scattering received thirteen (13) votes. We therefore declare Joshua Martinsen duly elected for the office of Director District 3 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 4 there were sixty-five (65) votes cast as follows: James A. Black received sixty-five (65) votes. We therefore declare James A. Black duly elected for the office of Director District 4 for the term of 3 years.

HINTON COMMUNITY

For the office of Director At Large there were seventy-four (74) votes cast as follows: Lynette Mona Blanchard received forty-two (42) votes; Brenda Baldwin received twenty-nine (29) votes; scattering received three (3) votes. We therefore declare Lynette Mona Blanchard duly elected for the office of Director At large for the term of 3 years.

KINGSLEY-PIERSON

For the office of Director District 3 there were fifty-seven (57) votes cast as follows: Scott Wayne Bohle received fifty-seven (57) votes. We therefore declare Scott Wayne Bohle duly elected for the office of Director District 3 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 5 there were fifty-four (54) votes cast as follows: Timothy P. Sudbeck received fifty-three (53) votes; scattering received one (1) vote. We therefore declare Timothy P. Sudbeck duly elected for the office of Director District 5 for the term of 3 years.

LEMARS COMMUNITY

For the office of Director District 2 there were eighty-seven (87) votes cast as follows: Cris Arthur Collins received eighty-seven (87) votes. We therefore declare Cris Arthur Collins duly elected for the office of Director District 2 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District At Large there were one hundred sixty-eight (168) votes cast as follows: Patrick Neil Murphy received eighty-four (84) votes; Mark E. Stelzer received eighty-four (84); scattering received one (1) vote. We therefore declare Patrick Neil Murphy duly elected for the office of Director District At Large for the term of 3 years and Mark E. Stelzer duly elected for the office of Director District At Large for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 3 there were seven (7) votes cast as follows: Richard J. Van Dam received seven (7) votes. We therefore declare Richard J. Van Dam duly elected for the office of Director District 3 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 4 there were ten (10) votes cast as follows: Shirley Ann Schroeder received ten (10) votes. We therefore declare Shirley Ann Schroeder duly elected for the office of Director District 4 for the term of 3 years.
