Bill Zales gave a presentation on land acquisition.

Several organizations, such as Pheasants Forever, Farm Bureau, Nature Conservancy, R C & D, and Zoning need to get together to organize land acquisitions in the Loess Hills area of Plymouth County.

Native prairie land acquisitions are important to the Board. The Conservation Board wants a commitment to protect property until it can be purchased. Real estate needs to be protected even before it's purchased.
