The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on February 19, 2008 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

The Canvass of the February 12, 2008 Special SILO Election was held with the following results:

Upon the public measure *“Shall the following public measure be adopted? A previously imposed local sales and services tax for school infrastructure projects shall be extended in the County of Plymouth at the rate of one percent. The tax will be extended until December 31, 2022. The money received from the tax shall be spent for school infrastructure, including purchasing, building, furnishing, reconstructing, repairing, demolishing, improving, expanding, or remodeling of a schoolhouse or schoolhouses and additions thereto, gymnasium, athletic facilities, field house, or school bus garage, purchasing and improving grounds, opening roads to schoolhouses or buildings, the purchase, lease or lease-purchase of buildings or equipment (including transportation and recreation equipment) as authorized by law, procuring or acquiring libraries, expenditures for energy conservation measures, the rental of facilities under Chapter 28E, for public educational and recreational activities, for any purpose or purposes now or hereafter authorized by Iowa Code Section 298.3 and 300.2, the payment or retirement of bonds issued under Iowa Code Section 423E.5, for debt reduction or property tax relief, or for any one or more of such purposes, or for any purpose or purposes now or hereafter authorized by law.”*

There were one thousand six hundred twenty (1,620) votes cast as follows:

FOR the question there were one thousand ninety-one (1,091) votes cast.

AGAINST the question there were five hundred twenty-nine (529) votes cast.

We therefore declare the public measure A to be adopted.

Motion by Greene, seconded by Henrich, to approve the Canvass of the Special SILO election held on February 12, 2008. Motion Carried.
