The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on January 8, 2008 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

The agenda for the January 8, 2008 meeting was approved.

Minutes of the January 2, 2008 meeting were approved.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson to approve the Winter Feedlot-Lagoon pumping project authorized by the City of Le Mars in the Joint Urban Renewal Area subject to a limit of \$100,000 in expenses. Motion Carried.

Motion by Greene, seconded by Anderson to approve a resolution naming county depositaries for the Plymouth County Treasurer. Henrich-aye; Kass-aye; Anderson-aye; Greene-aye; Schneider-aye. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass to approve \$93,000 out of the Local Option Sales Tax fund to purchase a tract of land for the Plymouth County Conservation Board. Motion Carried.

Tom Fleming, Wellmark Senior Account Manager, reviewed the ISAC group health program for FY 06-07 and discussed Plymouth County's health insurance plan for FY 2008-09.

Dennis Binneboese, Plymouth County Weed Commissioner, presented the FY 08-09 budget for the Plymouth County weed commission with a total of \$46,066.

Mike Van Otterloo, Plymouth County Sheriff and Kirk Hatting, Plymouth County Communication Center Coordinator presented the FY 2008-09 Budget for the Sheriff Department of \$1,053,741, Communication Center of \$277,066 and the Jail of \$848,574.

Joe Hook, owner of the Akron Hometown presented his request to be a county newspaper paid at full rate on all legal publications and minutes.

Motion by Henrich, seconded by Greene to approve a contest between the 4 county newspapers that have already submitted a request for 2008 by having each of them file a list of county subscriptions to the Auditor by the 1/15/08 board meeting according to Iowa code 349.

The Board recessed at 12:02 p.m.

The Board met at 1:00 pm to discuss the 2008-09 county budget.

The Board adjourned at 3:14 pm.
