The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on March 25, 2008 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

The Canvass of the March 18, 2008 Special Instructional Support Levy Election was held with the following results:

Upon public measure *“Shall the Board of Directors of the Le Mars Community School District in the county of Plymouth, State of Iowa, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years to levy and impose an instructional support tax in an amount after taking into consideration instructional support state aid, not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the total of regular program district costs for the budget year and monies received under Section 257.14, as a budget adjustment in the budget year, and be authorized annually in combination as determined by the Board, to levy an instructional support property tax upon all taxable property within the school district, commencing with the levy for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, and to impose an instructional support income surtax upon the state individual income tax of each individual income taxpayer resident in the school district on December 31 for each calendar year commencing with calendar year 2008, or each year thereafter, the percent of income surtax to be determined by the Board for each fiscal year to be used for any general fund purpose?”*

There were two thousand nine hundred ninety-one (2,991) votes cast as follows:

FOR the question, there were one thousand two hundred eighty-two (1,282) votes.

AGAINST the question, there were one thousand seven hundred nine (1,709) votes.

We therefore declare the public measure B not to be adopted.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Greene, to approve the canvass of the Special Instructional Support Levy Election of March 18, 2008 as presented. Motion Carried.

The agenda for the March 25, 2008 meeting was approved.

Minutes of the March 18, 2008 meeting were approved.

Motion by Greene, seconded by Henrich, to set the date of April 15<sup>th</sup> at noon for a joint public hearing in the City Council Chambers on the sale of Crescent Ridge Property. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Greene, to adopt Resolution #032508-1 authorizing the Plymouth County Auditor to levy a debt service tax pursuant to Chapter 76 of the Code of Iowa.  
Kass-aye; Henrich-aye; Greene-aye; Anderson-aye; Schneider-aye Motion Carried.

Chairman Schneider presented ISAC Years of Service awards to Craig Bartolozzi, Deputy Sheriff for 20 years of service and to Tom Rohe, County Engineer for 30 years of service.

Motion by Henrich, seconded by Kass, to authorize the Chairman to sign the Iowa Dept. of Human Service Comm. Mental Health Center Affiliation with Plains Area Mental Health. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to accept the bid of \$6,709.00 from Hagan Co. to purchase and install a 200 gallon vertical water storage tank at the County Home. Motion Carried.

The Board adjourned at 10:42 a.m.
