Motion by Greene, seconded by Anderson, to approve the November 10, 2009 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the November 3, 2009 minutes. Motion Carried.

Canvass of the November 3, 2009 City Election was held. Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the canvass as presented and approve the costs of said election. Motion Carried.

The Board of Supervisors received 2 bids for the painting of the 3rd floor of the Courthouse from Gary's Carpet Cleaning, Inc. for \$9,400.00 and from Wall Elements for \$8,106.00 which did not include the painting of the dome ceiling area.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the office siding for the Secondary Road building for \$18,250 from U.S. Window, Inc. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to open a public hearing at 10:33 a.m. for a road vacation of a portion of eight road right-of-ways in Plymouth County. Mark Kerberg and Ann Plendel from the public were present for the hearing. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Greene, to close the public hearing at 11:00 a.m. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Loutsch, to approve Resolution #111009 as an order to vacate and close a portion of some Plymouth County secondary road right-of-ways. Motion Carried.
