The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on October 6, 2009 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the October 6, 2009 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Anderson, to approve the September 29, 2009 minutes. Motion Carried.

During committee reports, Don Kass reported that the City of Le Mars Planning and Zoning Committee denied Plymouth County a variance for the set back and conditional use permit in order for a courthouse annex building to be constructed on the block of the courthouse.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve a contract with Karr Tuckpointing for tuck pointing the Residential Care Facility. Motion Carried.

Cathy VanMaanen of the Council on Sexual Assault and Domestic Violence was present and the Board of Supervisors read and signed a proclamation declaring October 2009 as "Domestic Violence Awareness Month" and commend the observation to all citizens.

Mike VanOtterloo, Plymouth County Sherriff was present to discuss with the Board the concerns he has with inmate medical expense and with the need for a contract with a company called Advanced Health Care in order to control the increasing costs to the taxpayer.
