The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on August 10, 2010 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present except Supervisor Greene. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the agenda for August 10, 2010. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Anderson, to approve the minutes of the August 3, 2010 meeting. Motion Carried.

The Board of Supervisors agreed to move the recycling dumpster, which is currently located at the Courthouse, to the Emergency Management Administration building. It will be placed along the north side of the metal building close to the alley, which is across the street from 127 3rd St. NE, temporarily during the construction to the Courthouse Annex building.
