The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on March 22, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present except Chairman Henrich. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the March 22, 2011 agenda with Don Kass as Vice-Chairman of the meeting. Motion Carried.

Motion by Guenther, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the March 15, 2011 minutes. Motion Carried.

The Plymouth County American Legion Auxiliary and the Plymouth County American Legion each donated \$100.00 to Plymouth County for the 1934 Constitution Lithograph. Dave Klingensmith also presented a check for \$50.00 to be given from Kingsley Post Nash #140.

Motion by Guenther, seconded by Anderson, to approve the courthouse annex change order for \$900.00 for the countertop change in the Driver's License room. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the bid to Campbell's Electric for \$3,416.60 to furnish and run all category 5 cable and install materials for the project in the courthouse annex building. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Guenther, to approve the final plan for project STP-S-CO75(129)-5B-75 and FM-TSF-CO75(125)-5B-75. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to accept the memorandum of the understanding along Hwy C60 on cemetery agreements. Motion Carried.

Discussion was held on the E.C. Lippke wetland issues in Section 14/15 of West Sioux Township. Jim Lahn, of NRCS, talked about working together on a compatible use agreement. There were several landowners present that expressed their concerns. The Board took no action and will continue to gather more information and to contact the DNR and Monica Monk, an easement team coordinator specialist with NRCS in Des Moines.
