The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on March 29, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the March 29, 2011 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Guentner, to approve the March 22, 2011 minutes. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Guentner, to approve pay application #3 for \$29,450, application #4 for \$4,227.50, and application #5 for \$15,430.85 for the ECO center for April 5th, 2011 per a site review by Board members.

Motion Carried.

Jack Guentner and Craig Anderson have been assigned by the Board of Supervisors to be the board representatives on the ECO center project.

Motion by Guentner, seconded by Kass, to approve the county surplus property list prepared and available from the Auditor, for the April 30, 2011 County surplus auction. Motion Carried.

Motion by Guentner, seconded by Anderson, to approve Resolution #032911 naming the Plymouth County depositories. Loutsch-aye; Guentner-aye; Henrich-aye; Kass-aye; Anderson-aye. Motion Carried.

Amanda Downey, Wellmark Account Sales Manager presented the ISAC group health insurance program financials for 2010-2011 and the premiums for 2011-12.

Sharon Nieman, Plymouth County CPC and Mental Health Director presented an update on SF481 and HF626 regarding MH changes for FY 11-12 and options for Plymouth County for the remainder of FY 10-11 including a one time fund transfer to the Mental Health fund.

Mark Kunkel, Manager of the Plymouth County Solid Waste Agency presented regarding the need to have 150th St. or Marble Ave. to the County landfill paved in the future. There were several residents present who live on 150th and Marble Ave. with concerns of the road conditions from the increased traffic due to the landfill location. They also expressed concern about nails and debris on the road, specific safety concerns and the concern that the County landfill will be in its current location for possibly 50+ years yet. The Board agreed to have Secondary Roads maintenance those roads twice a week and would like to receive new traffic counts on the roads before any decisions can be made.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to approve a tile permit in Section 26 of Elgin Township on Meadowlark Ave. and a permit in Section 2 of Fredonia Township on 100th St. Motion Carried.
