The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on January 24, 2012 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the January 24, 2012 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Guenther, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the January 17, 2012 minutes. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to set the Plymouth County Public Hearing for adopting the FY 2012-13 County budget for Tuesday, February 28th at 10:00 a.m. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Guenther, to approve a 3.5% salary increase in FY 12-13 to all non-bargaining unit employees that are not a deputy or an elected official. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve that Plymouth County pay 75% of the total NW Iowa Developers membership fee for FY 12-13 from the County General fund, which is \$14,054.63.
