The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on June 12, 2012 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the June 12, 2012 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Guenther, seconded by Anderson, to approve the June 5, 2012 minutes. Motion Carried.

Canvass of the June 5th Primary Election was held with the following results:

For the office of Board of Supervisor District 2 – Republican
Wayne Schipper received one thousand twenty (1,020) votes
Mark R. Loutsch received one thousand sixty-nine (1,069) votes.
We therefore declare Mark R. Loutsch duly nominated for the Republican candidate.

For the office of Board of Supervisor District 2 – there was no Democratic candidate

For the office of Board of Supervisor District 3 – Republican
Merlin C. Wagner received four hundred forty-two (422) votes
Don Kass received one thousand five hundred eighty (1,580) votes
We therefore declare Don Kass duly nominated for the Republican candidate.

For the office of Board of Supervisor District 3 – there was no Democratic candidate

For the office of Board of Supervisor District 5 – Republican
Dan Smith received nine hundred fifty-one (951) votes
Jim Henrich received one thousand one hundred seventeen (1,117) votes
We therefore declare Jim Henrich duly nominated for the Republican candidate.

For the office of Board of Supervisor District 5 – there was no Democratic candidate

For the office of County Sheriff – Republican
Mike Van Otterloo received one thousand eight hundred forty-four (1,844) votes
Jay King received three hundred fourteen (314) votes
We therefore declare Mike Van Otterloo duly nominated for the Republican candidate.

For the office of County Sheriff – there was no Democratic candidate

For the office of County Auditor – the Republican nominated candidate was Stacey Feldman
For the office of County Auditor – there was no Democratic candidate

Motion by Guenther, seconded by Anderson, to approve the canvass of the June 5, 2012 Republican Primary Election.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the canvass of the June 5, 2012 Democrat Primary Election.

Motions Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Guenther, to approve the Siouxland Regional Transit contract for FY 2012-13.

Motion Carried.

Motion by Guenther, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the Cost Advisory plan for FY 2012-13 regarding the Iowa Dept. of Human Services local administrative expenses reimbursement.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve a fireworks permit for Adrian C. Larsen for July, 4, 2012 unless a fire burn ban is in effect at that time.

Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Kass, to open the public hearing and reading of the Ordinance regarding Chapter 405 of the Code of Iowa limiting the assessment of housing development and granting authority to municipalities to extend the expiration of the limitation. Motion Carried.

No public were present for the hearing and no written comments were received. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Guenther, to close the public hearing and reading of the ordinance. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve Ordinance #061212 regarding the Code of Iowa Chapter 405 limiting the assessment of housing development and granting authority to municipalities to extend the expiration of the limitation and to waive the third reading of the ordinance. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Loutsch, for Plymouth County to join the Housing Trust Fund administered by SIMPCO with the option to withdraw, as presented by Kristi Quinn and Dwight Lang of SIMPCO. Motion Carried.

Linda Dobson, County Treasurer and Keri Borchers, Driver's License Deputy provided an update regarding the future of CDL testing in Plymouth County. Plymouth County does not have a future location for the new commercial CDL pre-trip skills tests and drives. Plymouth County will be able to continue to administer the CDL written exams, verify certifications and issue CDL renewals. The Plymouth County Driver's License Examiner, Steve Beeck, has also not attended the new CDL training or been certified with the new federal regulations due to not having a future location to use. After August 1, 2012 Plymouth County will no longer conduct new commercial drives under the old or new federal regulations.
