Sheriff Mike VanOtterloo gave the Board of Supervisors an update regarding the federal inmate and inmate census at the Law Enforcement Center. He also gave an update of the jail control computer system which is approximately \$30,000 and will be paid from the Inmate Room and Board Reimbursement Fund.
