The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on April 22, 2014 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present, except Jack E. Guenther. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the April 22, 2014 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the minutes of the April 15, 2014 meeting. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Loutsch, to declare a 2001 Ford F250 extended cab pickup as surplus property to be sold at the county surplus auction. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve \$500 of funding to the Small Business Development Center for outreach services in Plymouth County. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve Lakes Country Addition in Section 31 of Hungerford Township subject to the County Engineer's approval of driveways for Lots 1 and 2. Motion Carried.

The Board of Supervisors discussed changing the County structure in the Jt. Urban Renewal Area and will revisit the issue at the Board meeting on April 29<sup>th</sup>.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the application of emulsion in pavement joints on C16 and L12 and to seek clarification on charges on the second pass if necessary. Motion Carried.
