Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the April 8, 2014 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Kass, to approve the minutes of the April 1, 2014 meeting. Motion Carried.

Jack Guenther met with the Le Mars Public Library Board and presented the revised library association contract on April 7, 2014. The Le Mars Library Board turned down the revised contract with a 7-0 vote to not be included in the contract.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve the Secondary Road Budget and Construction Program to be presented to the Iowa DOT. Motion Carried.
