The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on August 4, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present; except Craig Anderson. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Chairman Henrich called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the August 4, 2015 meeting agenda. Motion Carried.
