The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on March 3, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Chairman Henrich called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the March 3, 2015 meeting agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Meis, to approve the minutes of the February 24, 2015 meeting. Motion Carried.

Peg Smith was appointed as a substitute for Doug Becker on the L.O.S.T. Advisory Board for District 4 for this year's allocating budget due to Becker having a conflict of time.

Eamonn Byrne and Rick Hansen from Plymouth Energy discussed the Iowa Natural Gas Replacement Tax and how it affects Plymouth Energy. They asked for the Plymouth County Board's support with a letter to the legislature addressing a change to the Replacement Tax. A letter will be drafted and added to next week's agenda.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve Resolution #030315 stating that road use shall be limited to a gross weight of 6 tons per axle on all trucks and other vehicles on Marble Ave from 160th Street south to concrete.
