The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on Tuesday, November 17, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Chairman Henrich called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors proposed the Secondary Road Bargaining Unit contract changes for a three year contract for FY 2016-17, FY 2017-18 and FY 2018-19 with a 1.5% salary increase the first year and 2% for both FY 17-18 and FY 18-19. They also proposed an increase to the employee's share of the insurance premium to 12.5% in FY 16-17, 15% in FY 17-18 and 17.5% in FY 18-19 and to allow employees to not have to use sick time during work hours when getting the annual wellness physical as long as the participation in the wellness program requirement is also agree upon.
