The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on Tuesday, September 15, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Chairman Henrich called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve the September 15, 2015 meeting agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to approve the minutes of the September 11, 2015 meeting. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to strike the Brett Udell Trucking Inc. payment for granular for \$425,568.94 as per the County Engineer, as he approved the wrong amount to be paid. The correct amount of \$219,775.52 is being authorized to be paid as a handwritten payment. Motion Carried.

Rebecca Krohn of the Executive Director of Siouxland Community Foundation and Judy Bowman of the Plymouth County Museum were present to discuss the sponsorship by Plymouth County for the Plymouth County Historical Museum until their 501(c) (3) status is reinstated.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Anderson, to authorize Plymouth County to be the Non Profit 501(c) (3) fiscal sponsor for the Plymouth Co. Historical Museum for the Endowment and Renovation funds with the Siouxland Community Foundation, upon proof of insurance and until the 501(c) (3) status has been reinstated. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Meis, to approve a 60 day extension from today, to file the minor subdivision, Plymouth Energy Addition. Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Loutsch, to approve a permit for Southern Sioux Rural Water for 3 crossings at 3 locations in the right of way in Section 30/31 of Meadow Township, Section 25/26 of Fredonia Township on 150th St. and Quest Ave. Motion Carried.
