The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on October 11, 2016 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present, except Don Kass. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Board Chairman Henrich called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to approve the October 11, 2016 agenda, removing the 11:00 am tour of the LEC communication center. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the minutes of the October 4, 2016 meeting. Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the payroll from October 10, 2016. Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Anderson, to approve a payment of \$14,000 to the City of Le Mars in FY 17/18 contingent on the award of the CAT grant of Vision Iowa Funds for the Le Mars Area Betterment projects. Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Loutsch, to approve a bored tile crossing permit between Section 3/10 of Elkhorn Township on C-66, a bored tile crossing permit in SW Corner of Section 17 of Union Township on Otter Ave. and to approve a bored tile crossing permit in Section 32 of Fredonia Township / Section 5 of Marion Township on 160th St. Motion Carried.
