The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on September 13, 2016 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Board Chairman Henrich called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve the September 13, 2016 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the minutes of the August 30, 2016 meeting. Motion Carried.
There was no meeting on September 6, 2016.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to approve the payroll from September 9, 2016 and claims from September 6, 2016. Motion Carried.

Alan Lucken discussed a continued problem of a violation of the Plymouth County Zoning Ordinance of accumulated junk on 18083 Iris Ave. by Justin Harms. The Board of Supervisors will turn the violation over to County Attorney, Darin Raymond.

Tom Rohe discussed an issue of dust on 300th St. due to the detour and trucks not using the proper detour due to the grading project on C-60. There has been a request from the Herbsts for some sort of help or dust control on 300th St. due to the increased traffic from trucks not following the proper detour. The Board of Supervisors took no action.
