The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on May 23, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Chairman Don Kass called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to approve the May 23, 2017 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Horton, seconded by Anderson, to approve the minutes of the May 16, 2017 meeting. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the payroll issued May 19, 2017. Motion Carried.

The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors and County Attorney Darin Raymond discussed the fireworks law as it relates to shooting and selling fireworks in Plymouth County. Per current Plymouth County Zoning and with following the IA fireworks law, any vendor wanting to sell in a temporary or permanent stand in Plymouth Co. will need to contact the Plymouth County Zoning department to receive the conditional use permit for a one year permit along with paying the \$200 fee to Plymouth County. The Plymouth County Board of Adjustment approves these permits. Vendors are required to meet insurance requirement and obtain their state license / permit with the State of Iowa Fire Marshall office per the State law. The Plymouth County Conservation Board approved to ban the shooting of fireworks in all Plymouth County parks with signs being posted, effective the meeting May 23, 2017. The Board of Supervisors concurred.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to approve a 28E agreement for Iowa Precinct Atlas Consortium and Plymouth County for the Auditor's office use of the Precinct Atlas Program for voting precincts. Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Horton, to approve the State of Iowa Department of Human Services Targeted Case Management lease agreement for offices at the Plymouth County 2nd Ave. Services Building for a 3 year contract. Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the renewal of a one year liquor license for Mike's Saloon. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Anderson, to open the FY 16-17 Plymouth County Budget amendment public hearing at 10:05 am. No members from the public were present. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Anderson, to close the FY 16-17 Plymouth County Budget amendment public hearing at 10:07 am. Motion Carried.

Motion by Horton, seconded by Meis, to approve the FY 16-17 Plymouth County Budget amendment as published. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Horton, to approve a permit to Iowa Lakes Electric for an electrical crossing in Section 12 of Remsen Township and Section 7 of Amherst Township in Cherokee County. Motion Carried.

Motion by Horton, seconded by Meis, to approve a right of way agreement for projects for LC-162401 and LB-131150. Motion Carried.
