The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on September 15, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Chairman Don Kass called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Horton, to approve the canvass of the September 12, 2017 School Election in Plymouth County as presented:

#### AKRON-WESTFIELD

For the office of Director District 1 there were forty-eight (48) votes cast as follows: Nick Schoenfelder received thirty-nine (39) votes; scattering received nine (9) votes.

We therefore declare Nick Schoenfelder duly elected for the office of Director District 1 for the term of 4 years.

For the office of Director District 2 there were twenty (20) votes cast as follows: Pam VonHagel received five (5) votes; scattering received fifteen (15) votes.

We therefore declare Pam VonHagel duly elected for the office of Director District 2 for the term of 4 years.

For the office of Director District 3 there were forty-seven (47) votes cast as follows: Josh Martinsen received forty-seven (47) votes.

We therefore declare Josh Martinsen duly elected for the office of Director District 3 for the term of 4 years.

For the office of Director District 4-to fill vacancy there were forty-eight (48) votes cast as follows: Cory Tucker received forty-one (41) votes; scattering received seven (7) votes.

We therefore declare Cory Tucker duly elected for the office of Director District 4-to fill vacancy for the term of 2 years.

#### HINTON

For the office of Director District At Large there were two hundred twenty-six (226) votes cast as follows: James D. Binneboese received sixty-five (65) votes; John Reintzel received sixty-two (62) votes; Erin Weiland received ninety-two (92) votes; scattering received seven (7) votes.

We therefore declare James D. Binneboese and Erin Weiland each duly elected for the office of Director District At Large for the term of 4 years.

#### KINGSLEY-PIERSEN

For the office of Director District At Large there were three hundred seventy-four (374) votes cast as follows: Jason Collins received one hundred seven (107) votes; Blake M. Laddusaw received one hundred four (104) votes; Kate L. Pratt received one hundred sixty (160) votes; scattering received three (3) votes.

We therefore declare Jason Collins and Kate L. Pratt each duly elected for the office of Director District At Large for the term of 4 years.

#### LEMARS COMMUNITY

For the office of Director District 1 there were one hundred fifteen (115) votes cast as follows: Todd Lancaster received one hundred fifteen (115) votes.

We therefore declare Todd Lancaster duly elected for the office of Director District 1 for the term of 4 years.

For the office of Director District 2 there were one hundred twenty (120) votes cast as follows: Scott Kommes received one hundred twenty (120) votes.

We therefore declare Scott Kommes duly elected for the office of Director District 2 for the term of 4 years.

For the office of Director District 4 there were seventy (70) votes cast as follows: Dave Miller received fifty-nine (59) votes; Brenda Phelan received three (3) votes; scattering received eight (8) votes.  
We therefore declare Dave Miller duly elected for the office of Director District 4 for the term of 4 years.

#### REMSEN-UNION

For the office of Director District At Large there were two hundred forty (240) votes cast as follows: Michael Sparr received seventy-three (73) votes; Robin S. Weiler received seventy-two (72) votes; Chris Poeckes received fifty-nine (59) votes; scattering received thirty-six (36) votes.  
We therefore declare Chris Poeckes, Michael Sparr and Robin S. Weiler each duly elected for the office of Director District At Large for the term of 4 years.

For the public measure “To adopt the revenue purpose statement specifying the use of revenues from the State of Iowa Secure an Advanced Vision for Education fund received by the Remsen-Union Community School District.”

There were one hundred seven (107) votes cast as follows:  
FOR the question, there were sixty-eight (68) votes.  
AGAINST the question, there were thirty-nine (39) votes.  
We therefore declare the public measure to be adopted.

#### WESTERN IOWA TECH COMMUNITY COLLEGE

For the office of Director District 1 there were one hundred ninety-two (192) votes cast as follows: Neal Adler received one hundred eighty-seven (187) votes; scattering received five (5) votes.

For the office of Director District 8 there were one hundred thirty-one (131) votes cast as follows: Russell C. Wray received one hundred thirty (130) votes; scattering received one (1) vote.
