The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on September 26, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated. Chairman Don Kass called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to approve the September 26, 2017 agenda. Motion Carried.

Motion by Horton, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the minutes of the September 19, 2017 meeting. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to approve the payroll dated 9/22/17. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to appoint Jim McNaughton to replace Jeff Gebauer on the Zoning Board to fill the unexpired term. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Meis, to approve the library contracts for FY 2017-2018 to disperse \$85,000 amongst the Akron, Kingsley, Le Mars, Merrill, and Remsen Public libraries. Motion Carried.

The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors discussed the nuisance property in Seney with Floyd Fiedler via conference call. He said he is in the process of lining up a contractor to build and enclose the house addition this fall and intends to clean up the property including a safety fence the weekend of Sept. 30 and Oct. 1st.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Horton, to have the Plymouth County Attorney prepare and send a letter to Floyd Fiedler regarding the nuisance property in Seney with the understanding that the Board of Supervisors would like to see significant progress with clean-up, a safety fence and an enclosed addition within 90 days from 9/26/17 with follow up by the County. Motion Carried.

Motion by Meis, seconded by Anderson, to approve Brady's Bard, a minor subdivision in Section 12 of Meadow Township. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to approve Frericks Addition, a minor subdivision in Section 23 of Remsen Township. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Meis, to approve a tile crossing permit in Section 9/10 of Elgin Township on Mahogany Ave. Motion Carried.

Motion by Horton, seconded by Anderson, to approve a water line crossing permit in Section 34/35 of Union Township on Polk Ave. Motion Carried.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Horton, to approve a permit for a tile crossing in Section 22/27 of Preston Township on 140th St. Motion Carried.
