Motion by Kestner, seconded by Spies, to approve a letter requesting a year's extension on the IDED grant.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from rural residential to commercial for Russ Holzman in Section 10 of America Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Spies, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Minnie Schmitt in Section 32 of Remsen Township. Motion carried.
