Motion by Kestner, seconded by Vander Hamm, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from ag conservation to ag rural residential for Mike Flewelling on Lot 2 on 3.63 acres in Section 24 of Union Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Spies, to approve the zoning boards recommendation for Flewelling Addition consisting of 3 lots in Section 24 of Union Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner, to approve the zoning boards recommendation for Century Creek Estates Second on 23.88 acres in Section 28 of Hungerford Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Vander Hamm, to appoint Dennis Schmid to the County Compensation Commission for 2001 as an ag property owner. Motion carried.
