Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Sitzmann, to authorize the Chairman to sign an application for grant monies for a victim witness coordinator program. Motion carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Kestner, to approve a beer/liquor permit and cigarette permit for Hidden Acres Golf Course. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner, to authorize the Chairman to sign a grant agreement with the DNR for \$15,000.00 for well testing, rehabilitation and abandonment. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Vander Hamm, to approve the purchase of 6 sets of baked enamel steel bathroom partitions for the county home from Langel Heating & Plumbing at a cost of \$3,162.00. Installation costs will be borne by Plymouth Life. Motion carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Kestner, to authorize the Chairman to sign an agreement for Federal-Aid Highway Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Program for project #BROS-CO75(76)—8J-75. Motion carried.
