The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on January 24, 2001 with all members present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the January 17th meeting were read and approved.

Board member, Dave Vander Hamm, announced the landfill board has hired Roger Dibble as the new manager of the Plymouth County landfill at a salary of \$42,000.00.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Kestner, to approve the Chairman signing a letter to DNR requesting funding in the amount of \$13,398.00 for a waste tire collection program in Plymouth County. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Spies, for the Chairman to sign a payment voucher for a draw down of state funds for Plymouth County Economic Development program. Motion carried.

Board discussed the Sheriff's office bargaining unit proposals. Sheriff Van Otterloo, gave some information on current policies to the Board. Board discussed courthouse personnel proposals with representatives from Attorney's office.

County Engineer, Tom Rohe, presented local grading guidelines for the year 2001. Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve fence replacement costs as presented. Motion carried.

Board gave approval for Tom Rohe to contact LeGrand and Company from Sioux City to get price information on appraisals for K-64 re-grading and resurfacing project.
