The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on March 7, 2001 with all members present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the February 28th meeting were read and approved.

The Conference Board hearing was opened at 10:05 A.M. Judy DeBoer took roll call. After one correction to the minutes discussion was called for and hearing none the hearing was closed at 10:10 A.M.

Motion by Darrel Schroeder, seconded by Marjorie Franke, to adopt the Assessor's assessment expense budget as published. Motion carried.

Motion by Marjorie Franke, seconded by Linda Smith, to adopt the Assessor's special appraisers budget as published. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Vander Hamm, to adopt
Resolution 030701

WHEREAS it is desirable and necessary that the axle weight of trucks and other vehicles operating on the Plymouth County roads shall not exceed 6 tons per axle during the period when the subgrades are unstable due to climatic conditions which cause the frozen soils to thaw and to remain unstable until the moisture content of the soil has dropped enough to allow the soil to stabilize.

THEREFORE BE RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Plymouth County, Iowa that trucks and other vehicles with their loads operating on and using roads of Plymouth County, Iowa, shall be limited to a gross weight of 6 tons per axle of all trucks or other vehicles including loads. This weight restriction shall apply to the following road:

- (1) Marble Avenue from 160th Street south to the concrete paving

This restriction will be operative from and after March 7, 2001 through May 25, 2001 and shall be enforceable when load restriction signs are placed. Ayes---Sitzmann, Spies, Vander Hamm, Kestner and Philips. Motion carried.
