The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on September 26, 2001 with all members present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the September 19<sup>th</sup> meeting were read and approved.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Kestner, to deny the request from the city of Le Mars to forgive taxation on the Westmar TIF due to the prohibition of transfer of funds to the debt service fund. Motion carried.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Vander Hamm, to approve an application for construction on county road right of way for Hickory Tech in Section 30 of Westfield Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Sitzmann, to approve an application for construction on county road right of way for Frontier Communications of Iowa in Section 13 of Stanton Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Spies, to approve an application for construction on county road right of way for Southern Sioux County Rural Water in Section 27 and Section 34 of Preston Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Sitzmann, to accept the purchase price of \$19,927.45 from Nuebel Chevrolet for a 2002 Impala. Motion carried.

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by Kestner, to approve a tax suspension for Milo Manning on property tax for Lot 7 Block 62 in Le Mars. Motion carried.

This hearing was opened for public comment on the Supervisor districts and voting precincts. Fifteen people were present. Hearing closed at 1:43 P.M.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Kestner, to adopt the supervisor districts as presented and approve Ordinance #092601 and waive the second and third readings. Ayes---Spies, Sitzmann, Kestner, Vander Hamm and Philips. Motion carried.

Motion by Kestner, seconded by Sitzmann, to schedule a hearing on October 10<sup>th</sup> for reprecincting at 1:00 P.M. in the boardroom. Motion carried.
