## July 9, 2002 Le Mars, Iowa

The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on July 9, 2002, to canvass the results of the Akron-Westfield School Special and the Kingsley Special held July 2, 2002. Present were Vice Chairman Kestner, members, Spies, Sitzmann and Philips.

The following results were found:

Upon the public measure "Do you approve of the Board of Directors of the Akron Westfield Community School District in the City of Akron, State of Iowa, adoption of resolution reducing the number of Directors from seven (7) to five (5) to be elected from four (4) director districts and one (1) at large district pursuant to Iowa Code section 275.23A, as amended?"

There were three hundred forty-nine (349) votes cast as follows:

**FOR** the question there were one hundred one (101) votes cast.

AGAINST the question there were two hundred forty-eight (248) votes cast.

We therefore declare the public measure "see above" not adopted.

Upon the public measure "Shall the City of Kingsley, in the County of Plymouth, State of Iowa, be authorized to establish a Municipally-Owned cable communications or television system, telephone or telecommunications system (including video, voice, telephone, data and all other forms of telecommunications and cable communications) Utility?"

There were thirty-three (33) votes cast as follows:

**FOR** the question there were twenty-seven (27) votes cast.

**AGAINST** the question there were six (6) votes cast.

We therefore declare the public measure "see above" to be adopted.
